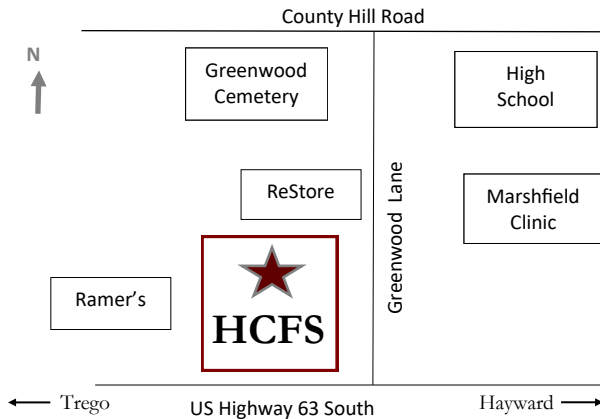

HOW YOU CAN HELP

HCFS is a 100% volunteer operated, non-discriminatory, 501(c)3 organization. No volunteer receives any compensation. No government funding. Your assistance is critical to meet the growing needs of our community.

◆ **Financial** donations including cash, credit cards through the HCFS website, stocks, bonds, IRAs, wills and memorials.

◆ **Food** donations directly to the Shelf, any food drive or local collection spot, such as MarketPlace (place on the acrylic shelf at the front of the store) or local churches. Except for produce, which is always welcome, food donations must be commercially produced.

◆ **Volunteer** your time. Volunteer applications can be found on the HCFS website.

◆ **Host a fundraiser or food donation** event for HCFS.

FREE FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

- ◆ **General Program** — Open every Monday & the first Saturday of each month from 9:00 — noon unless posted differently online and at the building. 3-5 day supply of food provided. Clients may come 1 time per month.
- ◆ **Food 4 Kids** — Available weekly during the school year through schools in Hayward and monthly during the summer at the Shelf.
- ◆ **Food 4 Seniors** — Available annually through the Meals On Wheels Program operated by the Senior Resource Center.
- ◆ **Food 4 Transition** — Available on demand through the Sawyer County Sheriff's Department.
- ◆ **Birthday Bags** — Available to children ages 3-9 during their birthday month.
- ◆ **Holiday Meal** — Extra ingredients for a holiday meal given in November (or December, if not collected in November).
- ◆ **Summer Picnic** — Extra ingredients for a summer picnic given in August.
- ◆ **TEFAP** — HCFS is the only distributor of this government program in Sawyer County.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ASSISTANCE

- Proof of residency in Sawyer County, Birchwood, Cable, Springbrook or Stone Lake
- Proof of social security number (from card or legal document) for each member of the household. Non-US citizens please see registrar.
